1. **Marine Transportation** and transshipment of Sludge from Linden OMAI Fuel Storage Facility to the Garden of Eden facility, capable to transporting and offloading, at least 760,000 imperial gallons.
2. **Engine Driven Pumping Service** that can handle high viscosity liquids via ship-to-ship transfer.

Overview

GPL is requiring the services of suitably qualified, competent, and equipped contractors to provide the following services:

1. **Marine Transportation** and transshipment of Sludge from Canefield , Versailles and Anna Regina Power Plants to the Garden of Eden facility, capable to transporting and offloading, at least 490,000 imperial gallons.
2. **Road Tankers** to transfer Sludge from Versailles and Anna Regina Power Plants to wharves on West Bank Demerara and Essequibo Coast, capable of transporting at least 8000 gallons at a time.
3. **Engine Driven Pumping Service** that can handle high viscosity liquids.

2. A copy of the Business Registration or Articles of Incorporation (if applicable).
3. A minimum of one (1) reference from entity/entities which fuel transportation services were supplied to in quantities upwards of 500,000 imperial gallons by marine transport within the past three (3) years.
4. Your quote validity (preferably a minimum of ninety (90) days).

1. Potential suppliers may bid for one (1) or both lots.
2. Bids must be submitted via email to GPL's electronic tender box: gpltenderbox@gplinc.com no later than **14:00 hrs on Monday, 19th July, 2021**.
3. Bid opening is scheduled for **14:30 hrs on Monday, 19th July, 2021** at GPL's Board Room 91 Duke Street, Kingston, Georgetown, Guyana.
